U of C Federal Credit Union board approves new name.

In keeping with the leadership role that U of C Federal Credit Union plays in the communities we serve, I am pleased to announce that our Board of Directors has approved a name change that will reflect the composition of our growing membership. Currently, less than 30% of our members are faculty, staff and students from the University of Colorado. The current name association is misleading given that membership is open to non-university members. The name selection process is underway, and will be announced on May 31st.

First, let me reassure you that the products and services you have come to rely on at U of C Federal Credit Union will remain exactly the same. Our unwavering commitment to our members for over 50 years will continue far into the future. Our ability to improve services on behalf of all members will continue as we broaden our membership base.

With over 70% of our membership now coming from companies and organizations not associated with the University, the Board of Directors felt it was time to select a name that better reflects our active role in the communities we serve. The new name will better communicate to individuals and families that membership is indeed open to them, a key to continued growth which will benefit all member-owners.

The naming process is underway.

Working with a team of experts that has helped 13 other credit unions with similar branding/naming projects, we are active in a process to rename U of C Federal Credit Union. This new name will mirror our community values and a heritage of putting the needs of our members first, while also reflecting the active Colorado lifestyle we all enjoy.
